



Review Hanover Fair 2006

The 2006 Hanover Fair took place between April 24 and 28 as a forum for users, developers and decision makers from all sectors of industry. 5,175 companies from 66 countries presented their products and solutions for industrial automation. 155,000 visitors came to the 154,800 sqm trade fair site in order to get an impression of the innovation capability of the investment goods industry. With around 30 percent of visitors coming from abroad, the Hanover Fair underlined its role as international automation fair.
